## SLIXS (Germany)

SLIXS (formerly known as the Stouxingers) has a unique style, with no a cappella clichés to be found in their powerful mix of jazz, pop, funk, classical and world music. These six multi-talented voices come from Berlin, Dresden, Leipzig and Halle. Honoured by acclaim from the renowned Swingle Singers and King's Singers, they have won some of the world's highest awards for vocal art, making the Best Jazz Song of the Year (2008) and the Best Folk/World Song of the Year (2013) at the Contemporary A Cappella Recording Awards (CARA). SLIXS has already rocked audiences at concerts and festivals across Europe and Asia and arrive in Hong Kong to a warm welcome.



## Jabberwocks (USA)

The Jabberwocks made a debut performance for HKFYG in 2006 when they delighted local audiences in Hong Kong. This all-male a cappella group from Brown University has a repertoire that ranges from 1950s doo-wop, to 60s Motown, to contemporary pop. Aside from regular appearances on American campuses, the band has performed in London, Paris, Amsterdam and Seoul. They have featured in awards at the International Championship of Collegiate A Cappella and have had numerous tracks appear on the Best of Collegiate A Cappella (BOCA) albums as well as being honoured in the Contemporary A Cappella Recording Awards (CARA).



## R.O.U.L (Korea) (to be confirmed)

R.O.U.L first got together in 2010 when they were all university vocal major students and they have over 200 successful performances to their credit. Today, this a cappella team from South Korea has a repertoire that includes mainstream pop and traditional Korean folk songs as well as alternative music. They cut their first studio album in October 2012 and it was released amid widespread praise. Their vision is to break down barriers and give a new edge to the Korean a cappella scene by bringing together exotic music with Korean traditional feel.



## HKFYG Hong Kong Melody Makers (HK)



The Hong Kong Melody Makers (HKMM) has evolved since 2004, when HKFYG was inspired to create its own youth choir. Now, the local young singers inspire in turn. Led by Artistic Director, Patrick Chiu, and sponsored by The Dragon Foundation, they benefit the entire community with their enthusiasm and versatility. In Australia, New Zealand, Japan, South Korea, Vietnam, China, Taiwan and Macau, HKMM has taken audiences' breath away. At the 2014 Incheon World A Cappella Competition, they won the "Best Vocal" award and wherever they are on stage they never fail to impress with innovative style and sheer dynamism.

The Musical Dinner is a fund raising event for the Federation to continue offering diversified, professional services for young people in Hong Kong.
